If the student completed requirements in Steps 1 & 2 \longrightarrow <u>Regents Diploma</u>

What if...

- (I) The student did not earn 22 credits? Students <u>must</u> complete credit requirements to get a diploma.
- (2) The student did not receive 65+ on all required exams? There are additional pathways for the student to graduate with a diploma.

The student's parent, not the school, requests a Superintendent's Determination.
